
2006-2007 COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

APPLICATION FOR CURRENT HIGH SCHOOL SENIORS

In its sixth year, the New York Chapter of the National Association of Asian American Professionals (NAAAP-NY) will award three (3) outstanding high school seniors the NAAAP-NY College Scholarship for distinguished performance in the combined areas of academics, extracurricular activities, and community services. Each winner will receive a one-time \$2,500 scholarship toward the use of college expenses.

In addition, one (1) student will also receive the Chan Lin Achievement Award. This special \$2,500 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating high school senior who immigrated to the United States within the past five years (no earlier than January 1, 2002).

All three parts of this application must be postmarked on or before January 31, 2007. Late or incomplete applications will not be considered. Only one entry per student is allowed. Multiple entries will be disqualified.

Asian* or Asian American students in their senior year at public, private, and parochial high schools in the New York metropolitan area** are eligible to apply. Applicants must also be citizens or permanent residents of the United States.

* As defined by the Census, Asian refers to people having origins from the Far East, Southeast Asia, or the Indian subcontinent. It includes Asian Indian, Bangladeshi, Cambodian, Chinese, Filipino, Hmong, Indonesian, Japanese, Korean, Laotian, Malaysian, Pakistani, Singaporean, Thai, Vietnamese, and Other Asians not listed.

** Includes in New York: Manhattan, Bronx, Queens, Brooklyn, Staten Island, Nassau, Suffolk, Rockland, Westchester, and Putnam; in New Jersey: Bergen, Essex, Union, Hudson, Passaic and Middlesex; and in Connecticut: Fairfield.
