In addition, one US-resident student will also receive the Chan Lin Achievement Award. This special scholarship for \$2,500 will be awarded to a graduating high school senior who has immigrated to the United States within the past five years (No earlier than January 1, 2001).

It is highly recommended that students complete the application on word processor first and then fill in the information on this application. Late or incomplete applications will not be considered and only application per student.

All three parts of this application must be postmarked on or before January 31, 2006. Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.

In order to be eligible for this scholarship, you must be a current senior in a high school in the New York Metropolitan area, expecting to graduate in the year 2006.
